BreatheNautics uses only technical and functional cookies, and analytical cookies that do not infringe on your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet, or smartphone when you first visit this website. The cookies we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website and your user convenience. They ensure that the website works properly and remember your preferences. We can also optimize our website with them. You can opt out of cookies by configuring your internet browser not to store cookies. Additionally, you can delete all information previously stored through your browser settings.
